As the cold closes in, it's business as usual at Masefield!

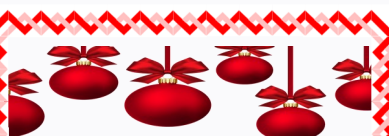
The new Enrichment groups have started across school so children can learn new skills and build their knowledge.

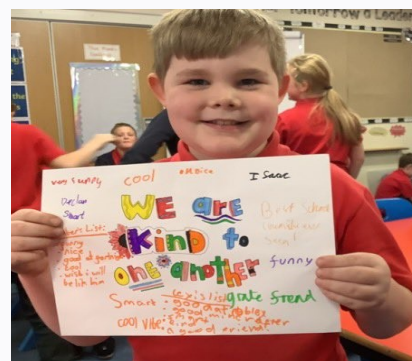

A massive well done and thank you to everyone that donated!



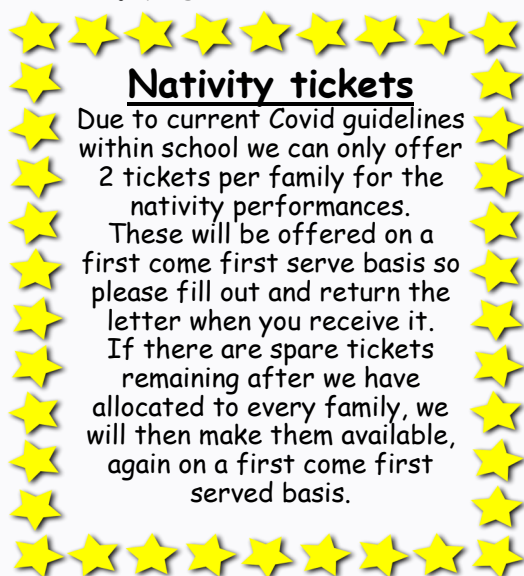
Year 5 Mindfulness enrichment class shared some kind words about each other last week.
