**Contribute-** To give or provide something

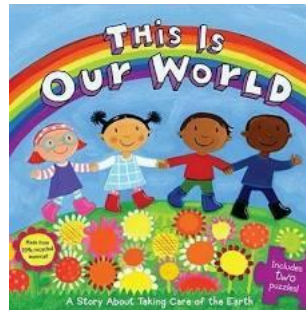
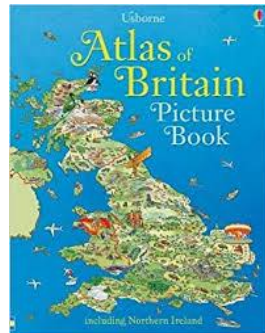
**Neighbours-** people living next door or nearby to you

**Liberty**- Freedom from being controlled

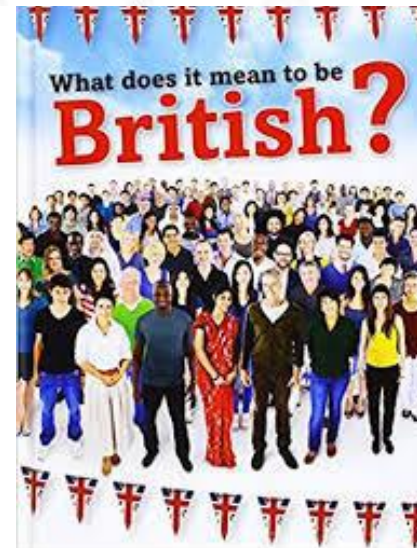
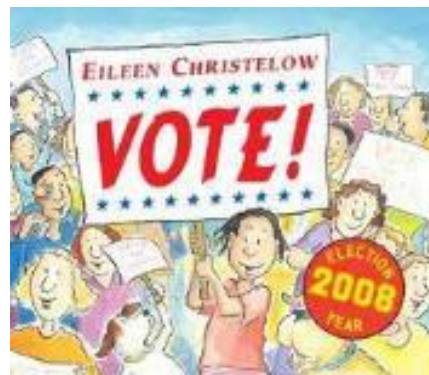
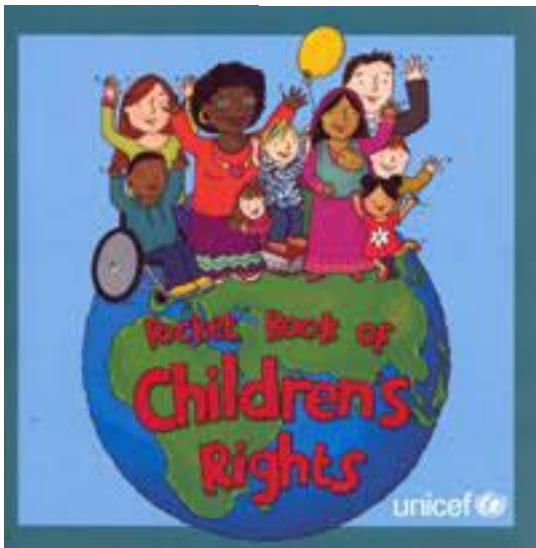
**Diverse**- Differences-people may be different in many ways e.g. age, ethnicity, appearance, religion etc.
