# **Vocabulary**

<u>Values</u> Principles or standards of behaviour; what a person judges is important in life.

#### Customs-

A tradition or usual way to behave. Many customs are things that people do that are handed down from the past.

**Impact**- To have an influence over something or someone.

**Fairtrade**- Trade between companies in developed countries and producers in developing countries in which fair prices are paid.

#### Climate change-

Significant long-term change in the expected patterns of average weather. Global warming and the climate changes seen today are being caused by the increase of carbon dioxide(CO2) and other greenhouse gas emissions by humans.

<u>Similarities</u>- When you consider how two things are the same or things they have in common

<u>**Differences-</u>**The opposite to similarities. How things are dissimilar.</u>

# <u>Vocabulary</u>

<u>Global citizen-</u> Someone who understands and is aware of the wider world, a belief that we can all make a difference.

<u>Sustainability</u> To be kept, avoidance of the reduction of natural resources.

<u>Global warming</u> A gradual increase in the temperature of the Earth's atmosphere.

**<u>Biodiversity</u>**- The variety of plant and animal life in the world, or particular habitat.

<u>Environment</u>- The natural world, the surroundings in which a person, animal or plant lives.

<u>**Prevent</u>**- Stop something from happening.</u>

<u>Energy</u>- Power from physical or chemical resources, especially to provide light and heat.

<u>**Responsibility-**</u> Having a duty to deal with something or having control over someone.
