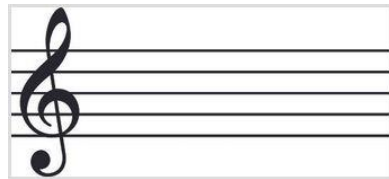
## Sticky Knowledge

- ✓ Florence Prince was born in 1887 and died in 1953.
- ✓ She was an American composer who made music in the Early 20<sup>th</sup> Century.
- ✓ In 1933 Prince overcame prejudice to become the first black female composer to have her work performed by a major orchestra.
- ✓ Prince's mother was a music teacher and encouraged young Florence to learn the piano.

## Important facts to know about Prince:

- ✓ After attending one of the few Music schools to accept African Americans, Prince taught music in Atlanta.
- ✓ Prince won a composing competition to get her first symphony played by the Chicago Symphony Orchestra.

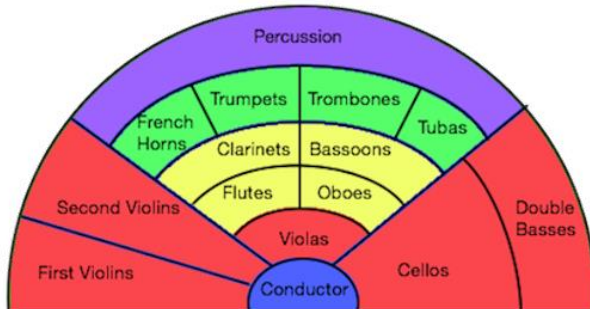

## Vocabulary

*forte*: play loudly

*piano*: play softly

**Tuned percussion**: percussion that plays high or low pitched sounds

**Untuned percussion**: percussion that only plays one pitch sound

*allegro*: play quickly

*adagio*: play slowly
