We have recently changed our online payment system for dinner money, snack and club payments.

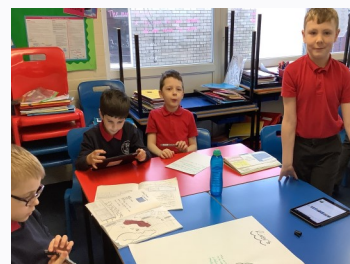

Some positive news for this weeks newsletter!

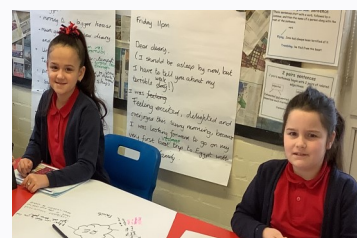
In the weeks leading up to Remembrance Sunday 2020 we sold various poppy merchandise to help raise money for the Royal British Legion.
