

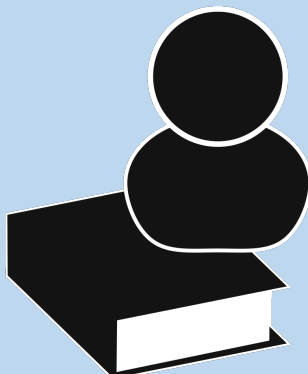

Plant seeds and watch them grow		Take part in a dress-up day.	

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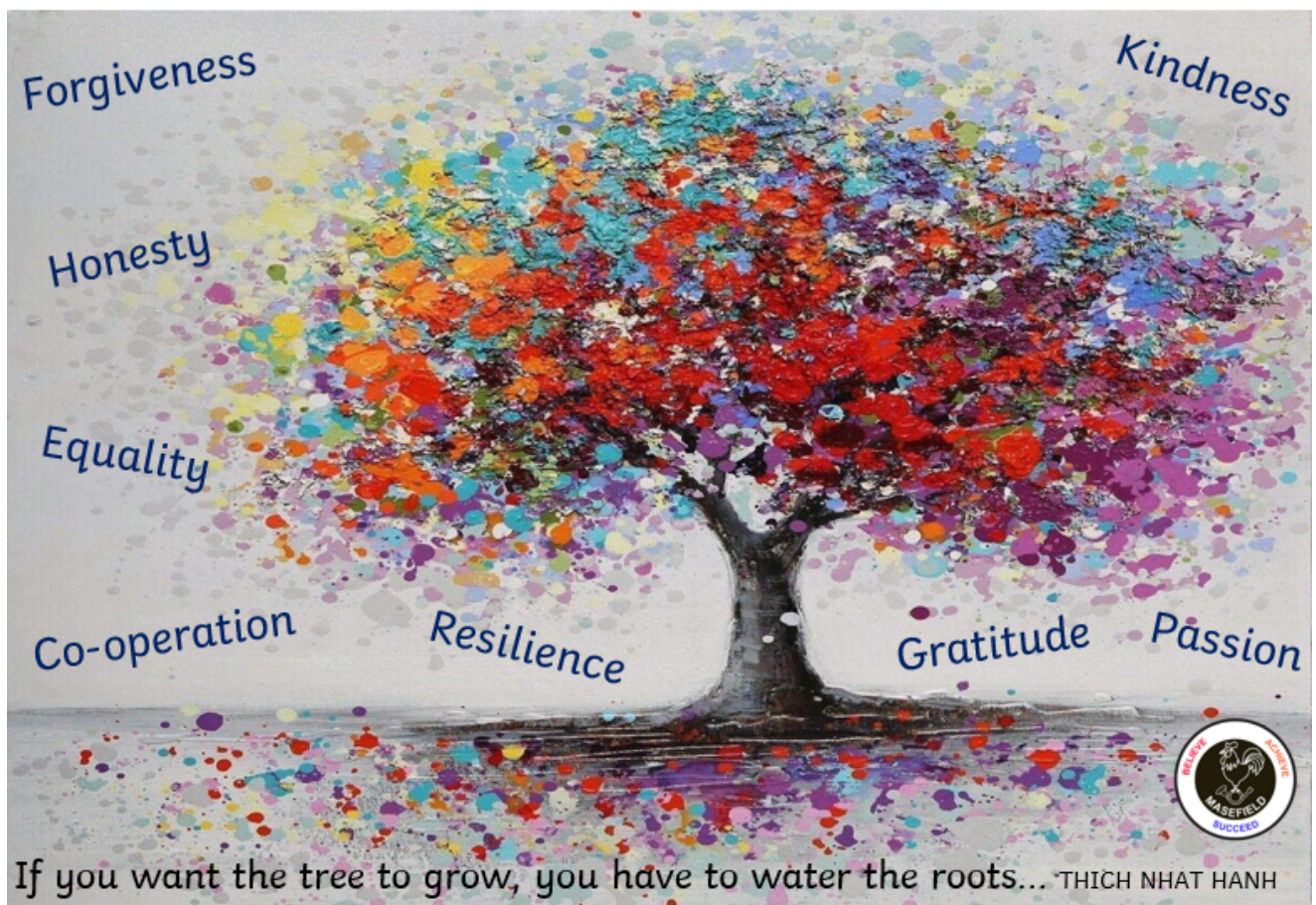
