These children were voted for by their peers in class.

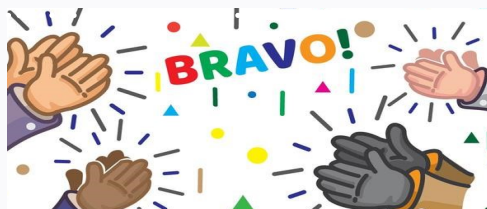
