## KCSiE Online Safety Roles and Responsibilities



#### **Bolton SICT**

- Maintain filtering and monitoring systems.
- Providing filtering and monitoring reports and alerts.
- Completing actions following concerns or checks to systems.
- Procure systems (with SLT and DSL).
- Identify risk (with SLT and DSL).
- Carry out reviews (with SLT and DSL).
- Carry out checks (with SLT and DSL).

#### Governors and Academy Trust Board

- Overall strategic responsibility for filtering and monitoring.
- Ensuring that filtering and monitoring standards are met.
- Identify and assign a member of the SLT and a governor to be responsible in ensuring that the filtering and monitoring standards are being met.
- Identify and assign the roles and responsibilities of staff and third parties, for example, external service providers.

#### Senior Leadership Team (SLT)

- Procuring filtering and monitoring systems.
- Documenting decisions on what is blocked or allowed and why.
- Reviewing the effectiveness of online safety provision.
- Overseeing all reports and alerts.
- Ensure all staff understand their role.
- Ensure all staff are appropriately trained.
- Ensure all staff follow policies and procedures.
- Ensure all staff act on reports and concerns.

# Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL)

- Overseeing and acting on filtering and monitoring alerts.
- Overseeing and acting on safeguarding concerns.
- Overseeing and acting on checks to filtering and monitoring systems.

# Teachers and Teaching Assistants

- Address online safety and appropriate behaviour in an ageappropriate way that is relevant to their pupils' lives.
- Report all inappropriate online behaviour or any online safety incidents following the reporting flowchart.
